HAVEN OF HOPE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

1. Full-time custody of at least one child under the age of 18.
2. No criminal history.
3. No active drug or alcohol case.
4. No open CYFD cases.
5. Must be working 32 hours or more a week, or going to school full time, or a combination of both.
6. Participate in Life Skills Training and Self Development
7. Upkeep of HOH room and community living areas
8. Ability to pay \$50 a month rent.
9. Must have a car.
